

BLASTER

The Red Chris mine has an opportunity within the Mine Operations Department for a Blaster. This position is for work at the remote Red Chris mine located 80 km south of Dease Lake, BC in Tahltan traditional territory. The successful applicant will be required to work and stay in camp during their shift rotation. We offer a number of designated flight marshalling points within BC. Qualified applicants from local communities are encouraged to apply.

Responsibilities

- Strong commitment and adherence to all Safety Policies and Procedures
- Reading instructions or diagrams, laying out drill pattern and determining depth and diameter of blast holes, conduct field tests
- Loading explosives in blast holes, connecting wire and detonating cords, connecting series to blasting machines
- Handle and store explosives in accordance to safety procedures
- Demonstrate effective safety leadership within a team environment and promote environmental awareness in all work or task related duties
