

JOURNEYMAN ELECTRICIAN

The Red Chris mine is recruiting for a Journeyman Electrician to join our Electrical Maintenance Department. This position is for work at the remote Red Chris mine located 80km south of Dease Lake, BC in Tahltan traditional territory. The successful applicant will be required to work and stay in camp during their shift rotation. We offer a number of designated flight marshalling points within BC. Qualified applicants from the local communities are encouraged to apply.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Reporting to the Electrical Supervisor responsibilites include, but are not limited to:

- Strong commitment and adherence to all Safety Policies and Procedures
- Perform maintenance and preventative maintenance activities such as the installation, testing, troubleshooting and repair of all electrical systems and equipment to ensure optimum reliability and availability while minimizing operational impacts and incurred costs
- Diagnose and repair tasks on power distribution, pit electrical shovels and drills, Mill production equipment and assist with repairs on all company mobile equipment
- Use of computer to input timesheets, work orders, parts lists, pick tickets, equipment information, troubleshooting feedback and shift turnover notes
- Strong commitment and adherence to Safety Policies, Procedures, Electrical Codes & Standards
- Demonstrate continuous effort to improve operations, decrease repair times, and streamline work processes. Actively participate in identifying and selecting technological improvements
- Mentorship and training of apprentices and supporting the instrumentation technicians
