

INDUSTRIAL HYGIENIST

The Red Chris mine is recruiting for an Industrial Hygienist (IH) to complement the Health and Safety team. This position is for work at the remote Red Chris mine located 80 km south of Dease Lake, BC, in Tahltan traditional territory. The successful applicant will be required to work and stay in camp during their shift rotation. There are a number of designated marshalling points within BC and we encourage applicants from the local communities to apply.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Advise on and support the implementation of IH programs to ensure compliance with regulatory and corporate requirements
- Maintain and continuously improve IH programs and processes
- Conduct Industrial Hygiene site assessments
- Conduct and lead all IH Monitoring and Sampling including Dust (Silica, Breathable and total), Lead (both airborne and surface), Diesel Particulates, Welding fumes etc.
- Interpret / analyze IH samples to assess potential worker exposure
- Prepare IH reports based on data collected and on site assessments
- Maintain the site Material Safety Data Sheet database
- Conduct regular Site Inspections and assist Workers/Supervisors in maintaining Safety
- Assist in Emergency Response as required
- Deliver Safety Orientations and training in Health and Safety related Policies and Procedures
- Joint Occupational Health and Safety Committee Management Representation and Resource

QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE

- Certified Industrial Hygienist or Registered Occupational Hygienist
- 3 years minimum experience in Industrial Hygiene
- Have a good understanding and knowledge of the BC Health, Safety and Reclamation Code (Mines Act) as it relates to Health and Safety

- Minimum Valid Class 5 driver's licence
- Valid Level 3 First Aid
- Current BC Surface Mine Rescue Certification is preferred, or willingness to obtain Certification

- Experience in conducting incident reporting, investigating and root cause analysis
- Have experience in completing on site inspections with respect to ensuring compliance with company policies and the Mines Act.
