Mount Polley Mining Corporation is seeking an experienced professional to join our hardworking and dedicated team. The *Fixed Plant Maintenance Planner* is responsible for the weekly and long term planning of section activities to ensure the safe achievement of department KPI targets.

This role reports directly to the Mill Maintenance General Foreman with functional reporting to the Maintenance Superintendent, Electrical Superintendent, and Shift Supervisors on a daily basis. The successful candidate will be responsible for the planning and scheduling of all corrective, preventative, and predictive maintenance carried out on surface fixed plant processing and non-processing infrastructure. The work schedule will be 4 10-hour day shifts of work followed by 3 days of rest.

- Effectively plan and schedule maintenance activities for routine and non-routine work
- Control resource allocation
- Manage forward and back-log work orders
- Create and maintain a library of routine preventative and corrective work activities
- Prepare and distribute the weekly maintenance schedule detailing the work for the following week
- Assist in preparation of the area maintenance budget
- Maintain, monitor and communicate defined maintenance KPI's
- Other duties as assigned by the General Foreman
