

# Tailings Storage Facility (TSF) and Mine Water System Manager

Mount Polley Mining Corporation has a position available for full-time TSF and Mine Water System Manager. The working schedule will be four (4) ten (10) hour shifts of work, Monday through Thursday, followed by three (3) days of rest.

#### Responsibilities

The Tailings Storage Facility (TSF) and Mine Water System Manager will report to the Mine Operations Manager or his designate, and is responsible for managing and providing oversight for all daily and scheduled tasks required in the planning, operation, maintenance, surveillance, and reporting on the TSF and water management systems at the Mount Polley Mine.

### Primary duties include:

- Overall responsibility for management of the TSF and mine water systems, including the site water balance
- TSF and water management system project planning and reporting
- Liaising with regulators and consultants (specifically the Engineer of Record) as relating to the TSF and mine water management, permit requirements and deliverables
- Budgeting and cost control, including contract management (consultant and contractors) and associated reporting
- Creating, distributing, updating and controlling relevant site documentation
- Administrative functions for direct reports

#### Requirements

- Minimum of five (5) years' experience in an open pit mining operation
- Minimum of five (5) years' experience in a project management position
- Minimum of bachelor-level education in related field from an accredited institution
- Experience with mine tailings and water management systems
- Valid driver's license
- Able to communicate effectively, both verbally and in writing
- Knowledge and use of Microsoft office programs, including Word, Excel and PowerPoint
