

Mill Operations Supervisor

Mount Polley Mining Corporation (MPMC) has positions available for full-time Mill Operations Supervisors. The work schedule will be seven (7) twelve (12) hour shifts of work followed by seven (7) days of rest, day and night rotation.

Reporting to the Mill Operations Superintendent the Mill Operations Supervisor is responsible for the direct supervision, safety and deployment of operating personnel involved in all mill circuits.

- First line supervisor of the mill operations crew
- Practicing and promoting company environmental, health, safety and operations policies and procedures. Ensure that site safety programs are adhered to
- Providing daily toolbox talks to the crew and organize monthly safety presentations
- Meeting commitments in tonnage and quality, equipment and manpower utilization, and budget/cost control
- Performance reports, skills assessments and effective deployment of personnel
- Encouraging and developing employee skill levels while maintaining the motivation of the crew
- Maintaining close communications with the Maintenance Department as required
- Perform other duties assigned as required by the company

Minimum Qualifications & Preferences

- Strong leadership and supervisory skills with a minimum of five (5) years in a supervisory capacity
- Minimum of twelve (12) years of experience working with crushers, ball and rod mills, flotation, dewatering and water treatment circuits
- Minimum of senior matriculation (Grade 12)
- Excellent oral and written communication skills, as well as good working knowledge of MS Office suite or applications
- Conflict resolution skills
- Valid driver's license
