

Mill Maintenance Superintendent

Reporting directly to the Mill Operations Manager, the Mill Maintenance Superintendent is responsible for guiding and directing all plant maintenance activities. The successful candidate will be responsible for the safe and efficient operation of the 20,000 tpd concentrator. In addition, the incumbent must have a strong focus on employee development to help achieve increased productivity and availability. Working schedule will be 4 days-10 hour shifts of work followed by 3 days of rest.

Job Description

- Analyzing and managing the mill maintenance area functionality
- Determining and implementing necessary changes to ensure production quota and procedures within financial parameters while ensuring adherence to safety, health and environmental regulations, policies and procedures
- Evaluating efficiency of mill maintenance areas to determine adequacy of personnel, equipment technologies used and develop necessary changes to work schedules and equipment when necessary
- Conferring with other supervisors to ensure mill maintenance is providing the necessary support and adjusting as required
- Establishing and maintaining necessary external networks and peripheral activities in support of the Mount Polley mine site
- Recommending staffing requirements, and participating in hiring process
- Conducting staff evaluations annually
- Assisting in resolving discipline related issues

Minimum Qualifications & Preferences

- 5 to 8 years supervisory experience in mineral processing environment
- Demonstrate excellent leadership, interpersonal and communication skills
- Excellent facilitating and coaching skills
- Experience with MS office software and keyboard skills, experience with SAP will be considered an asset
