

MILL OPERATOR IV

The Red Chris Mine has an opportunity within the Mill Operations Department. This position is for work at the remote Red Chris Mine located 80 km south of Dease Lake, BC in Tahltan traditional territory. The successful applicant will be required to work and stay in camp during their shift rotation. We offer a number of designated flight marshalling points within BC. Qualified applicants from local communities are encouraged to apply.

The mill (concentrator) is a 30,000 tonne per day plant that produces a bulk copper concentrate using the following unit processes and equipment:

- Gyrotory Crusher.
- Semi-Autogenous (SAG) and Ball Mill Primary Grinding.
- Tank and Column Cell Flotation.
- Ball Mill and Verti-Mill secondary regrinding.
- Concentrate Dewatering using a Thickener and Pressure Filter.
- Tailings Disposal.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND REQUIREMENTS

Reporting to the Mill Shift Supervisor responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Five years' experience operating gyratory crushers.
- Operates crusher system to reduce the run of mine ore to appropriate size for further processing in the mill.
- Performs housekeeping duties around the crusher area, including shoveling.
- Monitors raw ore being loaded into crusher pocket for foreign objects.
- Day to day inspections and monitoring a single stage gyratory crusher system.
- Work outdoors in all types of weather conditions.
- Ensure all equipment is operated safely and efficiently, and to notify supervisors of any unsafe conditions or required repairs.
- Ability to communicate effectively, verbally and in writing.
- Track data and complete shift report.
- Valid driver's license.
