Mount Polley Mine Operations Update #3

Evacuation Orders issued on July 15, 2017 for the City of Williams Lake and many surrounding areas were downgraded to Evacuation Alerts today. Mount Polley Mining Corporation (MPMC) is preparing to resume operations on Monday, July 31 (**B/D Crew**), with the intent of being back to full operations by Wednesday, August 2 (**A/C Crew**). This timeline will allow for employees who had been evacuated to return to their homes.

MPMC realizes that some employees and their families may still be under an Evacuation Order. MPMC will welcome any employee under Evacuation Order back to work if the employee feels it is appropriate to do so.

- the 10 hour bus will pick up at the Pioneer and the Ramada Inn, and travel to the mine site via McLeese Lake as the Likely road remains closed.
- the 12 hour bus will pick up at the Pioneer Complex and travel to the mine site via McLeese Lake.

MPMC will continue to support the decisions of our employees; however, if employees do not plan to return to work for their regularly scheduled shift, they are asked to follow the call-in procedure by contacting the mine at 250-790-2215 ext. 2203.

MPMC would like to provide our sincere thanks to all those providing professional and volunteer services in responding to the current forest fire situation.
